

## Getting to and from the Challenges of Europe Conference: about transportation



**12<sup>th</sup> International conference Challenges of Europe INNOVATIVE RESPONSES FOR RESILIENT GROWTH AND COMPETITIVENESS** gathers people from different places to the third largest island on the Croatian coast, Brač, near Croatia's second largest city, Split.

**VENUE:** Bol, Island Brač, Croatia, Bluesun Hotel Elaphusa

### **To and from the Split airport to the city of Split**

Split Airport is located in Resnik, between Trogir and Split.

**Public transportation** - there is bus no. [37 Trogir – Split](#) that leaves every 20 min of the hour from both Trogir and Split. The bus stop is near the airport, the ride takes about 40 to 50 minutes and costs 17 Kunas (approximately € 2.5). You can buy the ticket on the bus. The only currency accepted is Croatian Kuna.

There is also bus no. [38 Airport – Kaštel Stari – Split](#) that goes from 5 in the morning and again from 12 from the Airport for Split. Bus no. **38** also goes from Split from 10 until 15 (every 20 minutes) and then again from 19-20 (except Sunday & holidays).

It is recommended to come earlier to make sure that you don't miss it and you find a seat. More information is available at [www.promet-split.hr](http://www.promet-split.hr) (available only in Croatian).

If you're not a big fan of public transportation, there is also **shuttle transportation** organized with **Pleso** transport company. More information is available here: [PLESO TIMETABLE](#).

**Taxi** - You can find a taxi stand right in front of the airport, next to the arrivals gate. The taxi ride to Split usually costs more than 250 Kunas (approximately €33.8). You can use also Uber. **Uber** fare is about 225 Kunas (approximately € 30.4) in one direction.

**Rent a car** – near the airport there is a rent-a-car company, *Last minute*, where you can rent a car starting from 175 Kunas (approximately €24)/a day and get to the city and avoid the long bus drive. If you are arriving **by train** to Croatia, there is a line from Zagreb to Split. The railway station in Split is near the port, so you can easily continue your trip to Brač by ferry, catamaran or hydrofoil boat.

Split is also well-connected **by bus** with all bigger European cities, and the bus station in Split is near the port. So, if you reach Split by bus, you can easily continue your journey by ferry, catamaran or hydrofoil boat. The bus timetable is available here: <http://www.ak-split.hr/EN/>

## **To and from the island of Brač**

When you arrive to Split, you need to get to the ferry port to get to the island of Brač. There are 2 choices: ferry and catamaran.

### **Catamaran**

You can reach Bol directly from Split by catamaran. The catamaran leaves from Split every day at 16:00 and the ride lasts around 50 minutes. You can the tickets here: <http://www.jadrolinija.hr/en/schedule/LineSearchResults/Index/2331792/2331733/17052017>.

### **Ferry**

From Split you can take a ferry to Supetar on the island of Brač. You can find more info about ferry departure and book your ticket on: <http://www.jadrolinija.hr/>.

From Supetar, you can take a bus or taxi or you can go by car to Bol (it is a 39 km drive).

The bus ride from Supetar to Bol will take around 1 hour and the ticket price is approximately €7/person. More information on the Supetar-Bol-Supetar bus timetable is available here: <https://www.autotrans.hr/en-us/bus-supetar-bol> .

The taxi ride from Supetar to Bol is 40 min long and the price is roughly €55. Often, but not always, there are taxi mini-vans in front of the bus station in Supetar that can take you to Bol, for the price comparable to the bus ride.

If you are coming from the South of Croatia (from Dubrovnik) by car, take a ferry from Makarska to Sumartin on the island of Brač. The Makarska-Sumartin ferry timetable is available here: <http://www.jadrolinija.hr/en/sailing-schedule/local-lines-2017>. From Sumartin to Bol, it will take you about 40 minutes by car.

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
